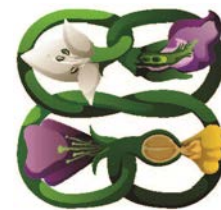

Meredith Welch-Devine is Director of Interdisciplinary and Innovative Initiatives for the University of Georgia Graduate School and is currently serving as Interim Assistant Dean.
